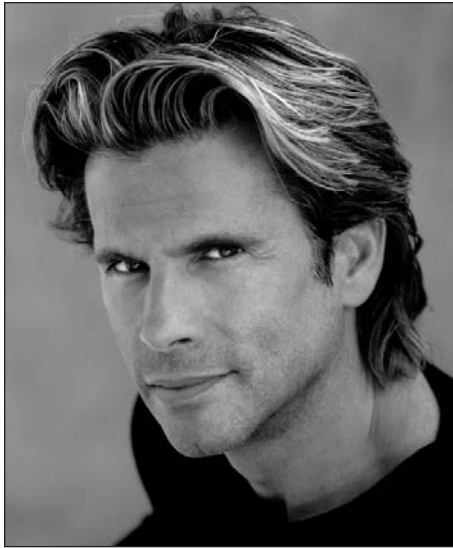

ABOUT THE ARTIST



Lorenzo Lamas

Lorenzo was born January 20, 1958 in Santa Monica, CA. He attended public schools in Santa Monica and Pacific Palisades until the age of 13. His mother, Arlene Dahl, the actress of stage and screen, had an opportunity to work in New York City on Broadway. The family moved to the East Coast and Lorenzo attended the Admiral Farragut Academy. This was a military school, where Lorenzo developed the character and discipline that would benefit him for the rest of his life. During his four years at Farragut, he became interested in athletics and lettered in wrestling and track. He was president of his senior class and second in charge of a battalion of 300 cadets. He graduated with the intention of enrolling in the University of California to study veterinary medicine.

During the summer of that year he visited his father, actor Fernando Lamas, on the set of Universal's *The Cheap Detective*. It was at this point that Lorenzo decided to pursue a career in acting. His father encouraged him to enroll in Tony Barr's actor's studio. Lorenzo was 19 when he was cast as Tom in the blockbuster movie *Grease*. After that he performed in several television shows before getting his big break from Earl Hammner, who cast him in the popular nighttime soap opera *Falcon Crest*. He had been studying Tai Kwon Do and the producers quickly realized how valuable his skills were. He was often called to perform in action scenes and after nine years on the show he was known as "an action type of actor."

He made several action movies after *Falcon Crest*, among them were *Snake Eater*, *Body Rock* and *CIA Target Alexa*, which he also directed. He was by now a black belt and met with Stephen Cannell to develop an action television series called *Renegade*.

However, it was the television show *Air America* that wet his appetite for aviation. The show's premise called for Lorenzo to spend many hours at the controls of an airplane and in 1997 he became a certified private pilot. His thirst for aviation and

freedom that this activity granted encouraged him to get his commercial helicopter rating as well.

Since 2004, Lorenzo has been starring as Los Angeles firefighter Hector Ramirez on CBS' long-running daytime drama, *The Bold and the Beautiful*.

Lorenzo has six children, ranging in age from 5 to 19 years of age. He is currently living in Southern California pursuing his goals and, thanks to God, enjoying his incredibly fortunate life.
